Step 1 — Export data

- Launch the Aeroqual S500 software and select File > Export Logged Data from the menu bar.
 The Export File dialog box appears.
- Use the date, time, monitor ID, location ID and sensor type filters to identify the data you want to export.
- Click Export.
- Select a directory, choose a file format (either plain text or MS Excel file) and click **Save**.
- Only data from one monitor can be exported at a time. You can export a maximum of 50,000 lines in one file. If there are more than 50,000 lines, you'll need to narrow your search parameters and do two smaller exports.
